

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

#### A. Conclusion

The researcher did a research to find out whether there was correlation between teachers' enthusiasm and learners' English achievement at SMA N 1 Rambatan. This research was correlational research. In this research, the researcher used quantitative data. In getting the data, the researcher gave teachers' enthusiasm questionnaires and learners' English achievement data. There were 35 item of teachers' enthusiasm questionnaire.

Based on finding as already discussed in the previous chapter, the researcher pointed out the conclusions. First, there was a positive correlation between teachers' enthusiasm and learners' English achievement at SMA N 1 Rambatan. It was proved by the coefficient correlation or  $r$ -counted = 0,91 and  $r$ -table = 0,87.

In conclusion, there was positive correlation between teachers' enthusiasm and learners' English achievement at SMA N 1 Rambatan. The correlation was categorized as high correlation. In other words, teacher who had enthusiasm affected the learners' achievement.

#### B. Suggestion

Based on the finding of the research, the researcher proposed several suggestions for teachers, students, and readers. First, after reading this research result, the English teacher would get information about the correlation between teachers' enthusiasm and learners' English achievement. Therefore, English teachers are

expected to develop their enthusiasm more. Second, the students are suggested to improve their interesting in learning English. By improving their interesting in learning English, their achievement will be improved too. It gives a positive impact each other. Then, in this research, the researcher only used questionnaire and learners' score, these could be some limitations of finding. The researcher suggested to the next researcher who has interested to this research to conduct other related research in the large scope.
